Sub:- Application dated 30.04.2013 of the Dean, Mahatma Gandhi Ayurveda College, Hospital & Research Centre, Salod (Hirapur), Wardha, Maharashtra to start new Post Graduate Course of Study in 05 subjects viz. (i) Agadtantra, (ii) Rasashastra & Bhaishajya Kalpana, (iii) Kayachikitsa, (iv) Panchkarma with 6 seats in each course and (v) Shalyatantra with 2 seats and to increase the admission capacity from 50 to 60 seats in existing UG (BAMS) course, Under Section 13A of the IMCC Act, 1970- Permission letter - reg.

Sir,

In continuation to the Department's letter of even No. dated 12.06.2014 wherein a Letter of Intent was issued to the college with respect to the proposals submitted to the Central Government as cited above, I am directed to say that after careful consideration of the recommendations of the CCIM in terms of the provisions of the IMCC Act 1970, relevant regulations of the CCIM and approved norms for the academic session 2014-15 vide Department's letter No.R.11011/10/2013-EP (IM-1) dated 17.06.2014 (available on Department's website <www.indianmedicine.nic.in>); permission of the Central Government is hereby granted to the **Dean, Mahatma Gandhi Ayurveda College, Hospital & Research Centre, Salod (Hirapur), Wardha, Maharashtra** to start new post-graduate courses in **05 subjects** namely (i) Agadtantra, (ii) Rasashastra & Bhaishajya Kalpana, (iii) Kayachikitsa, (iv) Panchkarma with 6 seats in each course and (v) Shalyatantra with 2 seats (the seats in the said PG courses will be subjected to the availability of eligible PG teachers for PG in concerned Department as per PG regulations) and to increase the admission capacity from **50 to 60 seats in existing UG (BAMS) course** at **Mahatma Gandhi Ayurveda College, Hospital & Research Centre, Salod (Hirapur), Wardha, Maharashtra** from the academic session 2014-15 under the provisions of the section 13A of the IMCC Act, 1970. Therefore, the college may take admissions for the academic session 2014-15.

2. This permission for starting of the above-mentioned PG courses and to increase in admission capacity from 50 to 60 UG seats for the first admitted batch of 2014-15 session, will be valid till such time as the first batch of students admitted against this courses appear for the first final examination of the said courses and at that time, the College authorities may take up the matter for recognition of the qualifications under Section 14(2) of the IMCC Act, 1970.

The college administration will ensure that sufficient qualified teachers in each new post graduate department, as per the relevant CCIM Regulations, are in position before the admission of the students in the above-mentioned new courses is made, under intimation to the Central Government and CCIM.

4. Further, to obtain the permission for academic session 2015-16 onwards to take admissions in the above said permitted courses and increased UG seats, college shall fulfil all the requirements of the IMCC Act, 1970 and the relevant Regulations made thereunder by 31.12.2014 and fulfilment of the conditions intimated by Department vide letter F.No.R.12011/11/2006-EP (IM-1) dated 03.07.2014 will be verified by the CCIM.
